Deacon Creek, a dynamic trio from the prairies of Manitoba, offers a riveting blend of Americana, contemporary folk, roots, and bluegrass inspired music. Comprising Aisha Belle, Kieren West, and Donovan Locken, the band captivates audiences with their intricate instrumentals and evocative lyrics that merge the essence of folk and bluegrass. Their harmonious vocals and thoughtful orchestration transport listeners on an emotive journey through familiar yet uncharted musical landscapes. The band's origin, rooted in a serendipitous meeting at the Winnipeg Folk Festival, infuses their music with a deep, personal connection. With their debut album "Shepherd's Purse" already stirring anticipation, Deacon Creek is setting out to release the album, in early October 2024. Their unique sound and compelling storytelling make them an unforgettable live performance act.

OSAC presents over 300 live community and school performances annually, attended by a total audience of approximately 75,000.
