

2020/2021 OSAC Performing Arts Micro-Grant Program

OSAC is pleased to announce the launch of the OSAC Performing Arts Micro-Grant Program. With the cancellation of the 2020/2021 performing arts season performances due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the OSAC Performing Arts Micro Grant program will give arts councils the opportunity to present performers in a safe, socially distanced manner if they choose to do so in the 2020/2021 season.

Available amounts: 50% of the artist fee to a maximum of \$500

Dates: September 1, 2020 to May 31, 2021

Qualifying activities: Any performance that is executed in a safe socially distanced manner that meets the performance and audience guidelines of the Government of Saskatchewan COVID-19 Re-Open Saskatchewan Plan.

Be sure to check the Movie and Theatre Guidelines & the Performing Arts Guidelines or the appropriate venue type if you are presenting in an alternative space.

Possible activities: outdoor performances, sidewalk or driveway performances, socially distanced indoor performances, drive in concerts, digital concerts. Other formats will also be considered.

Requirements:

- Available to all OSAC Arts Council members in good standing.
- The performance must be contracted either directly (Arts Council to artist) or through OSAC's normal contracting process.
- Application forms must be submitted to OSAC at least 2 weeks prior to the event.
- Grant amounts will be released once an event evaluation form has been completed.
